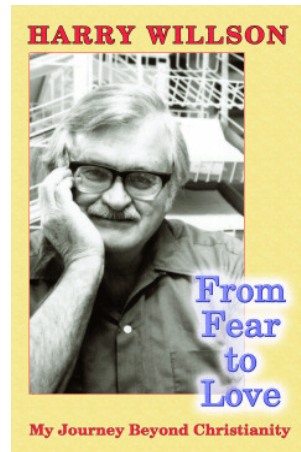

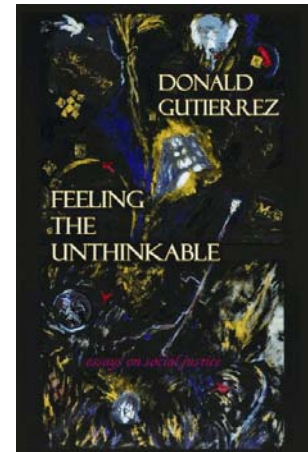

Two titles from Amador Publishers, *Feeling the Unthinkable: Essays on Social Justice* by Donald Gutierrez, and *From Fear to Love: My Journey Beyond Christianity* by Harry Willson, are finalists in the 2013 New Mexico-Arizona Book Awards. These rational reads inflame the mind with challenging subjects to stimulate the intellectual light within.

Gutierrez's essays on social inequality and government abuses are a dark but galvanizing call to change. His collection lifts the veil on the unthinkable acts committed by governments around the world, including our own, and calls for an end to the willful ignorance that enables them. Willson's self-examination provides us with an insider's perspective on organized religion and its teachings. The insights of this post-Christian philosopher describe a lifetime of self-discovery that will not soon be forgotten.

Thoughtful readers will be eager to plunge into these two books from a small press that excels in delivering relief from the usual dull parade of genre texts. The new titles are guaranteed to spark both mind and heart for those who are willing to think deeply about religion, patriotism, and matters that Americans don't often contemplate, but should.
